An online survey of 1527 Canadians was completed between August 20, 2021, and August 22, 2021, using Leger's online panel. No margin of error can be associated with a non-probability sample (i.e. a web panel in this case). For comparative purposes, though, a probability sample of 1527 respondents would have a margin of error of $\pm 2.5\%$, 19 times out of 20.

All percentages are rounded to the nearest whole number. Where a statistic is not included, the region did not meet the sample size minimum threshold for specific sub-questions.
