**Sample size is less than 100 respondents, however remains statistically significant. This Maru Public Opinion survey conducted on behalf of Royal LePage was undertaken by the sample and data collection experts at Maru/Blue. 811 randomly selected Canadian adults from Quebec who are Maru Voice Canada online panelists were surveyed from June 12th to June 14th 2023, among which a random selection of 228 respondents who are starting a rental property lease on July 1st 2023. The results of this study have been weighted by education, age, gender, region and language to match the population, according to Census data. This is to ensure the sample is representative. Discrepancies in or between totals are due to rounding.
